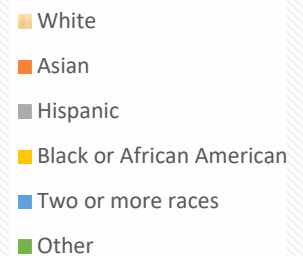
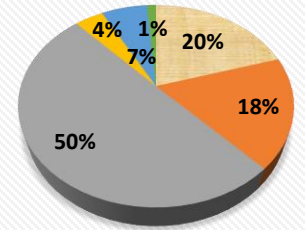

GRADING SYSTEM AND GPA SUMMARY:

Scholastic Grades: Eastlake High School assigns letter grades in all academic classes. Starting in Spring of 2020, No Credit Pandemic Grades were issued. Following CA state law AB 104, the option of Pass, No Pass & No Credit were added during 2020-21.

Overall Weighted: GPA is calculated from grades 9-12 and gives extra points for AP/Honors classes taken with earned grades of C or higher.

CSU "A-G" Weighted: GPA is calculated from California State University "A-G" classes taken starting in 10th grade, with earned grade of C or higher, restricted to giving weight to the first 8 weighted classes.

College Weighted Uncapped: GPA is calculated from California State University "A-G" classes taken with earned grade of C or higher, without being restricted.
